

26 March First National SITREPS Produced SITREPS = Situational Report





Community Focused Missions too...

New Jersey Wing fills in at food bank when there is a shortage of volunteers to meet the demand. CNN included Civil Air Patrol in their coverage.

Members set a new one-day record in the Hillside location's 45-year history for most meals packaged and then surpassed it, preparing 875 cartons on April 2, 1,030 the next day and 1,141 on April 14.






