SUBJECT: COVID-19 RESPONSE

1. After consulting with wing medical staff, I have decided to take the following action in response to the COVID-19 outbreak:
 - a. All CAP activities containing 10 or more personnel are prohibited unless they are actual emergency services missions or essential tasks and approved by the Wing Commander or Vice Commander.
 - b. All regularly scheduled squadron meetings, regardless of size are suspended.
 - c. All cadet flying activities are prohibited.
2. Activities of less than 10 people are permissible, but members are expected to exercise good judgment and consult the NHQ Coronavirus Risk Mitigation worksheet when considering activities. Any in-person activity involving cadets must be approved by the Wing Commander or Vice Commander.
3. Units are highly encouraged to conduct online meetings and activities in order to maintain participation.
4. Any member exhibiting any cold or flu-like symptom or has knowingly been exposed / in contact with infected individuals are prohibited from participating in any CAP activity.
5. Expanded guidance for Operations and Cadet Programs will be published separately.
6. These precautions will remain in effect until at least 31 MAR 2020. Superseding guidance from NHQ that is more restrictive automatically takes precedence over these restrictions.
