2. While COWG remains in Phase 1, all squadrons operating in a County having been placed under Level Red, must cease all indoor meetings and activities and are placed into Phase 0 of the COWG COVID remobilization plan.

3. COWG has suspended all non-mission essential activities in Level Red status counties. Per NHQ guidance, the wing commander can authorize activities and training that are considered mission critical while in Phase 0. Mission critical activities allowed include real world missions, single pilot proficiency flights, A9 maintenance sorties, flight evaluations, other ES specialty training and renewals (outdoors with 10 or less individuals). The wing commander may approve additional activities on a case-by-case basis.
