SUBJECT: Sortie Documentation Guidance

- 1. The following memo is created to provide guidance to COWG members regarding the expectations of CAPNHQ & CAP-USAF specific to sortie documentation.
 - a. CAPNHQ Reference: https://www.gocivilairpatrol.com/programs/emergency-services/pilots/web-mission-information-and-reporting-system-wmirs/brief-debrief-sorties
- 2. The general expectation for sortie documentation is that all fields on a sortie (CAPF104) are to contain pertinent information for that given sortie.
- 3. Specific fields of importance listed by Mission Symbol
 - a. All Symbols
 - i. Actual Depart (ATD) / Arrival (ATA) Times
 - ii. Hobbs, Tach
 - iii. Fuel/Oil purchase
 - 1. Fuel Sorties
 - a. Proper Fuel Receipt annotation, as specified in COWG supplement to CAPR 173-1
 - b. Fuel purchase source (CAPNHQ, COWG, or Member)
 - c. Indicate sortie fuel purchase details in Remarks field
 - i. Sortie numbers included on fuel purchase
 - 2. 'No Fuel' Sorties
 - a. 'No Fuel' indication/check box
 - b. Fuel purchase source (CAPNHQ, COWG, or Member)
 - c. Indicate sortie fuel purchase details in Remarks field
 - i. Sortie number where fuel was purchased
 - iv. Sortie Effectiveness for flown sorties (Successful/Marginal/Unsuccessful)
 - v. Any documentation identified during mission briefing
 - b. A5: AF Training and Evaluation
 - i. Hobbs To/From, Hobbs in Area
 - ii. Document training objectives
 - iii. Document training completed or not completed
 - 1. Document circumstances leading to non-completion
 - c. A12: AF Pilot Proficiency

- i. AFAM Profile completion documentation, as specified in CAPS 71-4
- d. A15: AF Cadet Orientation
 - i. Orientation Flight Syllabus (Sortie Manifest)
