# MEMORANDUM FOR COWG Pilots, COWG Commanders

SUBJECT: Air Sortie Funding

- 1. Starting Fiscal Year 2022, Colorado Wing implemented a "DRY" rate for all member-funded B and C missions. This payment format will remain in effect for FY24 (1 Oct 23-30 Sept 24).
- 2. For all member-funded B and C missions, members will now pay the CAPNHQ FY24 dry rate as published in CAPR173.3 (1 Oct 2023).
  - a. Member-funded B mission, 100% of the fuel will be paid using state funds. Fuel should be paid for with the MultiService credit card, and the receipt shall be uploaded to WMIRS.
  - b. Member-funded C mission (CO-Misc), members will be responsible for fuel costs and dry maintenance rates. Fuel should be paid for with the member's own credit card directly to the fuel vendor. If a member pays for their fuel, no receipt is required to be uploaded into WMIRS.
- 3. State-funded C missions will have all maintenance and fuel paid for with state funds.
- 4. Payment should be made to the wing IAW the current wing financial procedures utilizing electronic payment (Zelle) procedures if possible.
