

# Vehicle credit cards

Each CAP vehicle in Colorado has 2 credit cards in it – the EFS and the WEX cards. This will cover when and how to use each.

WEX Card

When to use which card:

- Fueling after a unit/group/wing non-mission activity – WEX card
- Fueling on/after a mission –
  - What category?
    - A – EFS (AFAM & AF funded)
    - B – WEX (AFAM & CAP funded)
    - C – WEX (No AFAM mission, CAP funded)
- Maintenance:
  - Under \$500 – EFS
  - \$500 and up – EFS ***AFTER*** coordination with COWG Transportation Officer
- Vehicle cleaning
  - Neither. Unit/member pays.

How to use:

Both cards require a driver number. The EFS uses a 4 digit number and the WEX uses a 6 digit number. Both are based on the vehicle number, which is a 5 digit number.

Vehicle Number – 05776

EFS driver number – 0577

WEX driver number – 005776

So, EFS number is first 4 digits, including the leading 0 and the WEX number adds a 0 in front of the vehicle number.

You will also need the odometer reading when fueling.

Sometimes, fuel systems will ask for a zip code with the EFS card. If so use 36112.

For maintenance work, use your CAPID instead of the mileage when asked. Mileage is just an information entry and National wants to know who is using the cards, so they want you to use your CAPID. If a zip code is asked for, use 36112. That's the zip code for CAP National Headquarters.
